Thank you for your submission to SICOT-J. We believe that you have the basis for an interesting article. Please see comments below to revise your paper. Please revise the paper carefully because revision does not guarantee acceptance. The major concern with this paper is presentation. A technique should be ideally validated with a series, however, this is obviously a case report. Therefore, either present as a technique, or as a case report.

Provide clear indications for the technique and approach.

Discuss potential complications and risks (as in the pearls).

List necessary tools and implants.

End the discussion by discussing what you were doing in the past, and how you obtained experience to do the present technique.

Citations: Please avoid sentences without references. Please add some citations from the journal; this will increase the prestige of the journal and the visibility of your article. Please correct the references according to the journal's instructions.

A table that summarizes the results of the most important published related studies would be useful and will add to your paper.

Illustrations: the legends should be explanatory (what the images show). The intraoperative (surgical) views are unclear and should better be omitted. Instead provide schematic illustrations.

Please revise carefully because revision does not guarantee acceptance of the paper.
