Reviewers' comments:

Reviewer #1: Thank you for your presentation.

Your manuscript presents a rare and clinically relevant sequence of postoperative pancreatitis followed by perforated diverticulitis after anterior lumbar disc placement. The topic is valuable and potentially novel. However, several methodological, interpretive and reporting deficiencies must be addressed before the manuscript can be considered for publication.

The main issues concern including overinterpretation of causality, incomplete clinical details, insufficient adherence to SCARE 2025 reporting standards, and redundancies and imprecision in the Discussion.

1. the article needs optimization and deletion of repetitive sentences spatially at discussion by write-off unnecessary informations like line 114 about (domino effect)
2. line 141 - 150 and 151 - 158 needs to be abridge
3. table 1 is not necessary
